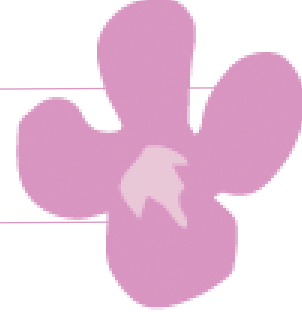

### Submit Your Book Bingo Card & Be Entered to Win Some Awesome Prizes!

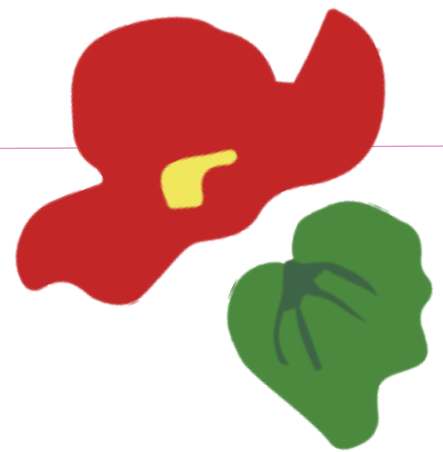
Submit the front **AND** back of your completed card (with either a Bingo or Blackout) **in only one of the following ways:**
